Laws § 42-35-8 the **Energy Facility Siting Board (Board)** will conduct a public hearing regarding the above captioned matter on **Thursday, December 10, 2020 at 1:00 PM at 89 Jefferson Blvd. Warwick, RI, Hearing Room A.** The purpose of the hearing is for the Board to hear oral argument on the above-captioned matter. In the Petition for a Declaratory Order filed with the Board on September 16, 2020, The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid seeks a ruling by the (Board) that the temporary installation and operation of portable liquefied natural gas vaporization equipment on Old Mill Lane in Portsmouth, Rhode Island is not a major energy facility as defined by R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-98-3(d) and Rule 1.3(16) of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure and as such is not subject to the Board's jurisdiction. The Petition is on file and available for public review at the offices of the Board at the Public Utilities Commission office building and at www.ripuc.org/efsb. The deadline for parties to file for intervenor status in this matter is 4:00 PM, November 20, 2020.
