Dear Ms. Rodvien,

Pursuant to the Rhode Island Energy Facility Siting Board Order No. 147, at 11 n.5, the Company is hereby providing notice that it will be mobilizing liquified natural gas ("LNG") equipment at its property located at Old Mill Lane, Portsmouth (the "Facility") to support the natural gas supply to Aquidneck Island. This mobilization is needed as a backup supply to the natural gas distribution system during the transmission pipeline owner's scheduled inspection of the lateral pipeline that supplies the Island. Attached as Exhibit A is a copy of the notice dated August 13, 2021 ("Notice") that was supplied to Rhode Island Public Utilities and Carrier Division pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR §193.2019. As stated in the Notice, the Facility will be operated between August 30-31, 2021. Provided there are no capacity constraints from the pipeline inspection, the Facility is only expected to be on standby during the day.

Consistent with previous mobilizations, the Company has reviewed the upcoming mobilization with the town administrators and emergency responders for the Towns of Portsmouth and Middletown. The Company will mail the notice to the abutters of the upcoming mobilization the week of August 16th. Attached as Exhibit B is a copy of the notice.

Site setup is expected to commence August 23, 2021, and once the equipment is delivered, security will be present 24/7.

Pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR §193.2019, National Grid is hereby notifying the Division of a temporary portable LNG set-up at Old Mill Lane, Portsmouth, RI (Assessor's Parcel 68-74).

The set-up of temporary LNG is to provide system reliability while the transmission company, Algonquin, is performing inspections on their piping systems. National Grid, as a policy, installs portable LNG equipment as a backup to these inspections. We are providing notification of these inspections which are scheduled to operate August 30 – August 31.





Algonquin Gas Transmission, the owner and operator of the transmission pipeline that feeds Aquidneck Island, will be performing an additional inspection of its pipeline from August 30-31, 2021. During this time National Grid and its contractors will temporarily locate equipment on its Old Mill Lane property to provide a backup gas supply in support of Algonquin's operation.

Prior to the Algonquin's start date, National Grid's contractors will be conducting minor site work to allow the equipment to be located on the site in a manner that limits disturbance to the property. The facility will be manned at all times by security guards and National Grid personnel.
