Conservation Law Foundation supports Burrillville's July 13, 2017, Motion To Dismiss, and respectfully urges the Energy Facility Siting Board to grant the Motion.

Burrillville's Motion is based on a jurisdictional requirement of the Energy Facilities Siting Act. R.I. Gen Laws § 42-98-8(a). As such, it cannot be waived by the EFSB under any circumstances. Yetner v. Corkery, 706 A.2d 1331, 1332 (R.I. 1998).

Indeed, failure to dismiss in this circumstance would be reversible error. <u>Goode v. United States</u>, 305 F.3d 378, 386 (6th Cir. 2002 ("jurisdictional defect requires reversal").
