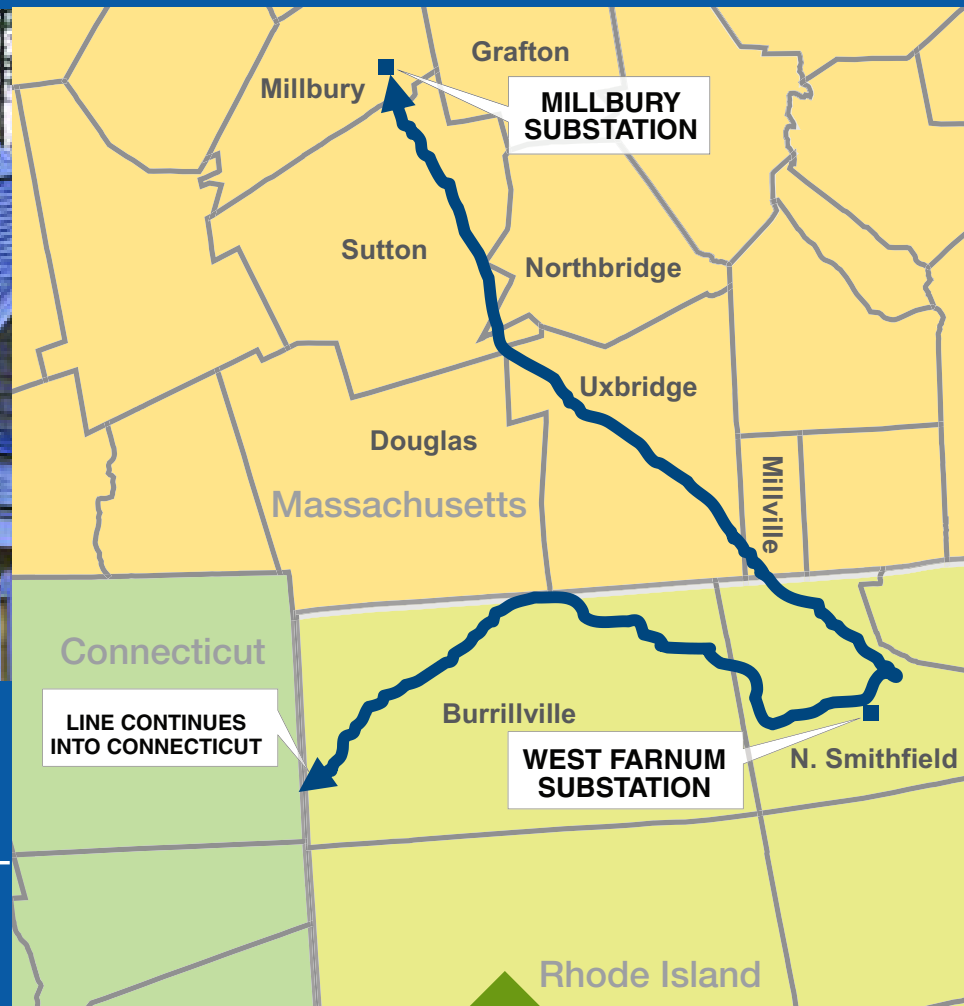

To strengthen the reliability of the regional electric system, National Grid is proposing to add a 345-kilovolt transmission line in the existing utility rights-of-way through the towns of North Smithfield and Burrillville, RI. The proposed Interstate Reliability Project is part of the New England East-West Solution (NEEWS), a group of transmission projects designed to strengthen reliability in southern New England.
