Dear John-

You have requested that Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC ("Algonquin") evaluate whether Invenergy LLC ("Invenergy") could be permitted to use the existing Algonqin access road to its Burrillville, Rhode Island Compressor Station (the "Station") during construction of the Invenergy power plant contemplated in Burrillville, and perhaps as a permanent access road to the proposed plant.

Algonquin has reviewed this request with various internal groups, including transmission, which is responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Station, and it has determined that it cannot allow Invenergy to use the existing Algonquin access road for its construction and operation activities. Use of the access road may pose security risks at the Station site that would not be in the best interests of an interstate natural gas transmission pipeline company. Algonquin needs an open access for emergency vehicles, normal and major maintenance activities, and clear access for our employees. As such, if there was an issue at the Station and access was restricted due to Invenergy's traffic from construction or normal activities, this could impair operations at the Station which is critical to maintaining required gas supply to the northern Rhode Island and Massachusetts areas. Maintaining security and Station access would be more difficult with additional vehicles and people using the road that do not have business at the Station.

So for the safety of our employees that work at the station and the security of the Station, we respectfully deny your request to share the access road.
