MOTION FOR INTERVENTION OF THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY d/b/a NATIONAL GRID

Pursuant to Rule 1.10 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Energy Facility Siting Board (EFSB), The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid (National Grid), respectfully files this Motion for Intervention. On November 17. 2015, the EFSB opened Docket SB-2O15-06, regarding the proposal of Invenergy Thermal Development LLC's ("Invenergy") to site a 900 megawatt (MW) gas-fired combined-cycle electricity generating facility in Burrillville, Rhode Island. In its Application to the Rhode Island Energy Facility Siting Board, Invenergy represents that its generating facility will connect to National Grid's Switching Station via a new 6-mile long electric transmission line to be installed and owned by National Grid. National Grid's interconnecting 6-mile transmission line is a Major Energy Facility requiring review and approval of the Energy Facility Siting Board.

Intervention in EFSB proceedings is governed by EFSB Rule 1.10. Since Invenergy's proposed generating facility will be connected to National Grid's transmission line and switching station, National Grid is seeking intervention pursuant to EFSB Rule 1.10(b)(2) as its interests are directly affected by this proceeding, are not adequately represented by the existing parties, and the Board's action in the proceeding may be binding on National Grid.

WHEREFORE, National Grid hereby respectfully requests to be granted leave to intervene in this proceeding as a full party.
