I am a resident of Burrillville, RI. My husband was born here and I moved here when I was 12. We moved to VA for four years while he served active duty for the U.S. Navy. We moved back to Burrillville and rented an apartment in Pascoag.

The gasoline station contaminated our water with MTBE, which hurt my family, but me physically (lost most of my hair, hurt and destroyed some of my bone density and now suffer migraines). After this we still wanted to stay and raise a family here because of the wonderful lakes, wood and quiet.

We both work over an hour away, but still wanted to be in Burrillville, so we bought a house in 2011. My health as the result of the previous MTBE incident has resulted in faster progressing RA and Fibromyalgia. As much as I don't want to leave, if this new plant is put in, it will not only affect my well water, air quality and noise pollution, but my overall health as well as my husband's and children's health.

My question is to you, would you do this to you kids and family?

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
