I wanted to speak tonight, but had to leave before I could to get to bed for camp the next day. I go to the Mother of Hope Camp on Pascoag Reservoir/ Echo Lake. This beautiful lake will be affected by this proposed power plant. It has a blue heron that lives there and ducks and fish and lots of other animals along with humans. I'm afraid that this power plant will make these beautiful things dirty, and migrate away. I like seeing them and feeding them. I maybe little and have selective hearing, but I hear it all. I'm afraid that I will have to move from the house I live in just to be safe. I don't want to move, my dog passed away and is buried in the back yard! I want to stay with him. I like visiting him when I miss him. Also I hear that the board people think that the town people don't care, lots of people do care, but they may not be able to come to the meetings. My Dad usually comes and my Mom stays home with me and my brother because the meetings go on very late, past my bedtime and we need our rest for school/camp tomorrow. My Dad represents 4 people. I am scared and don't understand why you are going to build something that will hurt us.

I have learned that you, our governor, went to the same elementary school I go to: St. Philips School! At our school we are taught to conserve the environment by recycling, turning off lights when we leave a room, not being wasteful with food or water and loving and caring for all things God made, like trees, clean air, animals and people. Why are you knocking down trees which help clean the air, taking homes away from animals, to build a power plant that will hurt us making the air dirty and our water dirty?

What is going to happen to me? To my family and friends? Nature? And our World? I feel that the people who are for this power plant are bullying the people who are against it! Why did you allow the union people into the meeting? They

make me scared. Why do you want to let something that will hurt us come into our town? I'm scared I could die if this power plant is built!
