We feel we are lucky that we do not own our house but rent, so that we will not face the dilemma of trying to sell and move if the plant does get built. If this plant is built we will leave and move to Mass. My mother and sister also will do the same as they live in

I feel this plant will literally rip my family apart, as my sister will move towards Connecticut to be closer to her husband's work at Electric Boat.
