This matter came before the Energy Facility Siting Board (Board or EFSB) on a Motion to Intervene filed by Kevin Smith. Mr. Smith is the owner of real estate on Jepson Lane in Middletown, Rhode Island approximately 100 feet from the proposed new Jepson Substation. The basis of Mr. Smith’s motion, filed pursuant to Rule 1.10(b)(2) of the EFSB Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules), is that the proposed facility will negatively impact the value of his property. The Board finds that his interests will be directly affected and cannot be adequately represented by existing parties. There was no objection to the Motion.

The Motion to Intervene should be granted.
