Notice of Public Hearing

Pursuant to the provisions of RIGL Chapters 42-98 and 42-35 and sections 1.6(f), 1.6(g) and 1.2(d) of its Rules of Practice & Procedure, the Energy Facility Siting Board ("Board") will conduct a public hearing on an application filed by Rhode Island LFG Genco ("Ridgewood") on April 1, 2009 at 6:00 PM at the RI Resource Recovery Corporation ("RIRRC") Administration Building, 65 Shun Pike, Johnston, RI 02919.

In this application, Ridgewood filed a notice of intent to construct an approximately 0.5 mile 115 kV power line that will facilitate the interconnection of Ridegwood's proposed new-waste-to-energy facility to existing transmission facilities. The project is proposed to be constructed over land currently owned by the RIRRC and will not involve any other residential or commercial property.

Section 1.6(f) of the Board's rules provides for an abbreviated review in cases involving the modification or relocation of certain power lines. The purpose of this hearing is to take public comment regarding whether the proposed project "may result in significant impact on the environment or the public health, safety and welfare" thereby requiring a full Board review. If the Board determines that the project will not result in a significant impact, the project may be determined not to constitute an alteration and may proceed without further review.

The application is on file and available for public review at the Board office in the Public Utilities Commission (PUC), 89 Jefferson Blvd., Warwick, RI 02888, or at [www.ripuc.org/efsb/index.html](http://www.ripuc.org/efsb/index.html). The PUC and the RIRRC are accessible to the handicapped.
