The Rhode Island DSM Collaborative met four times in the summer of 2003 to discuss, negotiate, and achieve the terms of a final settlement on the Narragansett Electric Company's Demand Side Management Programs for 2004. The following records summaries of these four meetings.

- Programmatic enhancements for 2004 were proposed for consideration.

- A schedule was created for Company and Collaborative activity to meet the goal of a settlement for the 2004 programs being filed during the first week of September.

- The Company presented a proposed budget for 2004 of \$22.1 million.
- An incentive structure featuring \$603,000 for reaching savings targets and \$75,000 for five performance metrics was also presented.
- A few significant programmatic changes for 2004 are expected: reduction of rebates for Energy Star Heating, full scale implementation of comprehensive Small Business Services, ending copayment for light fixtures in the EnergyWise program.
- The Company reviewed its schedule to meet a September 5 filing target.
