**MOTION TO INTERVENE OF RNK, INC. D/B/A
RNK TELECOM**

Pursuant to Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") Implementation notice dated September 18, 2003, RNK, Inc. d/b/a RNK Telecom ("RNK") respectfully requests the Commission to grant RNK the right to intervene in the above-referenced matter. In support of its Motion to Intervene, RNK states as follows:

1. RNK is authorized by the Commission to provide telecommunications services to end users in Rhode Island as a Class I competitive local exchange carrier.
2. RNK will be directly affected by any decision made by the Commission in this proceeding. This proceeding will have a substantial impact on the price and availability of unbundled network elements in Rhode Island and, as such, will impact any future competitive choices RNK will make for future expansion of competitive services to Rhode Island consumers. Further, RNK may be able to provide a unique perspective into the competitive barriers facing small carriers in Rhode Island.
3. As a small competitive facilities-based local exchange carrier in Rhode Island, no other party can represent RNK's interests effectively.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth and consistent with Section 1.13(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, RNK respectfully requests that the Commission grant RNK's Motion to Intervene.
