

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In accordance with Paragraph 8.(C) of the Second Amended Settlement Filing dated October 15, 2004 and approved in Docket 3617 (the "Settlement"), The Narragansett Electric Company ("TNEC" or "Company") hereby submits its Report of Environmental Response Costs for the period April 1, 2004 through March 31, 2005.

This report is organized in general accordance with the information requirements specified in the Settlement. Section I presents a monthly summary of contributions to the fund and payments from the fund to determine the fund balance for the period April 1, 2004 through March 31, 2005, including interest at the customer deposit rate.

Section II presents a summary of payments by expense type. Subsections IIa through IIp provide a breakdown of payments for each manufactured gas plant site ("MGP") or other environmental site listed in Exhibit 9 of the Settlement. Section III provides additional detail of consultant and contractor costs. Backup data for each environmental site such as invoices, purchase orders and requests for checks are available for review upon request.

The site is approximately 4 acres and is now the front lawn of the Guiteras Middle School. A portion of the site has been capped and is monitored annually.

The majority of the former gas plant is now a parking area for the former textile mill that once operated on the site. The parking lot is now a part of an on-going condominium development by others. TNEC is negotiating a settlement which will reimburse the condominium developer for environmental remediation required by the RI Department of Environmental Management and to secure Environmental Land Usage Restrictions and Easement on the property. The settlement will not include impacted sediments adjacent to the condominiums.

TNEC is required to remediate and dispose of impacted soils during the ongoing redevelopment activities.

N. Melrose Street

The property at 280 Melrose Street, operated as a service center by The Narragansett Electric Company since 1923, is currently under investigation and remediation for the presence of contaminants associated with its historical usage. Among other contaminants, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) have been detected in various media at the property, including in soil, concrete, asphalt, and building materials (floors, walls, etc.). The PCBs are present due to historical releases and spills of PCB-contaminated mineral oil dielectric fluid (MODF), a substance used in many types of electrical equipment. Remediation of the property will occur following receipt of a clean-up plan approval from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency.
