**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 39-1-1 and 39-3-11 of the General Laws, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) will conduct public hearings on the following dates and locations:

The hearings may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required.

In this docket, the Commission will examine the propriety of an application by the City of Woonsocket Water Division (“WWD”) seeking approval to implement new rates designed to generate additional revenues in the amount of \$2,067,150, an overall increase of approximately 38% over current revenues. If approved, the impact on a typical residential customer with an annual consumption of 10,000 cubic feet will be an increase of \$110.62 per year or 38%. The impact on other retail customers will vary based on classification and consumption. The Commission can approve different rates that may be higher or lower than those proposed by the Woonsocket Water Division.

The filing is on file for examination at the Commission's office and at the office of City of Woonsocket Water Division, 1500 Manville Road, Woonsocket, RI.
