ORDER

WHEREAS, On July 5, 2005, Pascoag Utility District (“Pascoag”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) a Tariff Advice modifying its reconciliation filing requirements for Standard Offer Service, Transmission and Transition from semi-annual to once annually; and

WHEREAS, On July 27, 2005, the Division filed a Memorandum recommending the Commission approve Pascoag’s Tariff Advice with the caveat that Pascoag file a six-month status report to show the actual balances of the three accounts and the projected under- or over-recovery at the end of the twelve month period; and

WHEREAS, On July 28, 2005, at its Open Meeting, after review of the filings, the Commission approved Pascoag’s Tariff Advice, specifically approving RIPUC #963, #964, and #965 with the caveat that Pascoag file a six-month report as discussed above for informational purposes only, unless Pascoag’s filing is accompanied by a request to change rates.

Accordingly, it is

(18312) ORDERED:

1. Pascoag’s Tariff RIPUC #963, canceling Tariff RIPUC #959 entitled Transmission Charge is hereby approved for effect August 4, 2005.

2. Pascoag's Tariff RIPUC #964, canceling Tariff RIPUC #960 entitled Standard Offer is hereby approved for effect August 4, 2005.
3. Pascoag's Tariff RIPUC #965, canceling Tariff RIPUC #962 entitled Transition Charge is hereby approved for effect August 4, 2005.
4. Pascoag shall file clean copies of the approved Tariffs within thirty (30) days of this Order.
