Pursuant to Rule 1.13 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Public Utilities Commission, Interstate Navigation Company d/b/a the Block Island Ferry (Interstate), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby moves to intervene as a full party in this matter. Island Hi-Speed Ferry, LLC.
