NOTICE OF TECHNICAL RECORD SESSION

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws §§39-1-1 and 42-46-6, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) will conduct a Technical Record Session on **Friday, December 8, 2006 at 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A of the Public Utilities Commission, located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The technical session may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required.

In this docket, the Commission will examine the components of a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (“Agreement”) jointly submitted and entered by and between National Grid (“Company”), the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, the Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources, People’s Power and Light. LLC and The Energy Council of Rhode Island seeking approval of the Company’s 2007 Demand Side Management (“DSM”) Programs and services with an overall budget of approximately of \$22,527,800. The proposed budget includes a mandatory charge of \$0.0020 per kWh (legislatively mandated by the Rhode Island Utility Restructuring Act) for application in the billings months of January through December 2007. The proposed budget is to fund and implement energy efficiency programs targeted at different classes of residential, commercial and industrial customers.

The Settlement is on file for examination at the Commission’s office and at the office of National Grid, 280 Melrose Street, Providence, Rhode Island. The filing can also be accessed at www.ripuc.org/eventsactions/docket/3779page.html.

Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws; specifically Sections 39-1-7, 39-1-8, 39-1-11, 39-1-12, 39-1-18, 39-1-20, 42-35-8 and 42-35-10.
