**MOTION OF INTERVENTION BY EAST SMITHFIELD WATER DISTRICT, TOWN OF
LINCOLN - LINCOLN WATER COMMISSION, GREENVILLE WATER DISTRICT,
CITY OF EAST PROVIDENCE AND THE CITY OF WARWICK**

Now comes the East Smithfield Water District, Town of Lincoln - Lincoln Water Commission, Greenville Water District, City of East Providence and the City of Warwick pursuant to Section 1.13 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission and hereby file this Motion to Intervene as co-intervenors with Kent County Water Authority which and as filed with the Public Utilities Commission on May 14, 2007 and the co-intervenors aver and submit the following in support of their motion:

1. The proposed increase represents a substantial increase in the wholesale price of water to the co-intervenors which will be passed on to their residential, industrial and business customers.

2. The proposed increase and tariff filing of the Providence Water Supply Board would increase the wholesale price of water by 26.15% from \$1,236.00 per million gallons to \$1,248.00 per million gallons, plus a new fixed monthly charge of \$97,944.00, or \$1,175,328 per year.

3. The proposed increase will be passed on to and will be reflected in high bills for water to residents, industries and businesses in the areas served by the co-intervenors.


4. The interests of the co-intervenors, as well as the interests of their industrial residential and business customers, would be directly affected by the granting of the rate request of the Providence Water Supply Board, and such interests be adequately represented by their participation with other parties. Further, and consistent with the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Public Utilities Commission and Section 1.13 thereof, the co-intervenors aver and believe that their intervention is in the public interest.

5. That the co-intervenors aver that Kent County Water Authority shall be the lead intervenor and that the co-intervenors hereby adopt and affirm the pleadings of the Kent County Water Authority as it applies to the co-intervenors.

WHEREFORE, the intervenors make this Motion that the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission allow them to intervene as parties in this docket and to advocate their interest and the interest of the rate payers and residents of the several communities to which they distributes water.


