

**MOTION OF THE GEORGE WILEY CENTER FOR CONTINUANCE OF  
PUBLIC COMMENT HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT  
DEADLINE**

The George Wiley Center, by its attorney, moves that the Public Utilities  
Commission (PUC):

1. Continue until November 12, 2007 the public comment hearing now scheduled for October 11, 2007 at 10:00 am; and
2. Continue until November 30, 2007 the written comment deadline now scheduled for October 29, 2007.

As grounds for this motion, the George Wiley Center states as follows:

- The George Wiley Center represents numerous low-income people who will be affected by the proposed amendments to the PUC's regulations;
- Many low-income people will want respond to these proposed amendments, both orally and in writing;
- These affected people need additional time to learn of the amendments and to prepare their responses for the public comment hearing and/or in writing;

- The Wiley Center needs additional time to pose appropriate data requests prior to tendering its responses at the public comment hearing and/or in writing;
- The George Wiley Center understands that other affected parties, such as National Grid and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, had time respond to these proposals and to pose data requests before the proposed amendments were publicly announced;
- All interested parties must be afforded a reasonable opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments. G.L. §42-35-3(a)(2); PUC Rules of Practice and Procedure § 1.8 (f)(ii).

The Wiley Center understands that the Division has no objection to this motion.

The Wiley Center has not yet heard back from counsel for National Grid.

WHEREFORE, the George Wiley Center asks that its motion be granted.
