Dear Mr. Rosenfield,

On July 12, 2013, in Order No. 21103, the Commission recertified the Putnam Hydropower facility as both an eligible Existing and New Renewable Energy Resource. Seventy-two percent (72%) of the monthly generation from the Putnam Hydropower Generation Unit was found to meet requirements for eligibility as an Existing Small Hydro Renewable Energy Resource and was assigned the unique Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission Certification Number RI-3937-E13. Twenty-eight percent (28%) of the monthly generation from the Putnam Hydropower Generation Unit was found to meet the requirements for eligibility as a New Small Hydro Renewable Energy Resource and was assigned the unique Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission Certification Number RI-3937-N13.

This is to clarify that in accordance with Commission Order No. 21165 (issued 9/26/13), twenty-eight percent (28%) of the Renewable Energy Certificates ("RECs") are eligible as New RECs and seventy-two percent (72%) are Rhode Island-eligible as Existing RECs effective on July 11, 2013. RECs associated with the production of eligible energy that are minted on or after July 11, 2013 are eligible for the Rhode Island Renewable Energy Standard in the percentages set forth above.
