**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 39-1-1 and 39-3-11 of the General Laws, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) will conduct public hearings on the following dates and locations:

June 26, 2008 @ 7:00 P.M.	Pawtucket City Hall Council Chambers 137 Roosevelt Street Pawtucket, Rhode Island
September 3, 2008 @ 9:30 A.M.	Public Utilities Commission 89 Jefferson Boulevard Warwick, Rhode Island

The hearings may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required.

In this docket, the Commission will consider the propriety of an application by the Pawtucket Water Supply Board (“PWSB”) seeking to implement new rates designed to increase revenues by \$3,109,387 to support a total operating revenue requirements of \$20,938,109 or an overall increase of 17.4% over current revenues. If approved, the bill impact on a typical residential customer with an annual consumption of 10,000 cubic feet will be an increase of \$91.28, from \$357.88 to \$449.16 per year or 25.5%. The Commission can approve different rates that may be higher or lower than that proposed by the PWSB.

The application is on file for examination at the Commission’s office and at the office of the Pawtucket Water Supply Board, 85 Branch Avenue, Pawtucket, Rhode Island. The application can also be accessed under the Commission Docket Menu at [www.ripuc.org](http://www.ripuc.org).

Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws; specifically Sections 39-1-7, 39-1-8, 39-1-11, 39-1-12, 39-1-16, 39-1-18, 39-1-20, 42-35-8 and 42-35-10.
