MOTION OF THE PORTSMOUTH WATER AND FIRE DISTRICT TO INTERVENE

The Portsmouth Water and Fire District ("Portsmouth") hereby moves to intervene in this proceeding. In support of this motion, Portsmouth states that:

- 1. Portsmouth purchases all of the water that it supplies to customers within the Portsmouth Water and Fire District.
- 2. The City of Newport Utilities Department, Water Division ("Newport"), is the sole supplier of water to Portsmouth.
- 3. Portsmouth estimates that it will purchase approximately 446,500,000 gallons of water from Newport during Newport's next fiscal year, which runs from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
- 4. Portsmouth purchased an average of 441,370,000 gallons of water from Newport during each of Newport's previous five fiscal years, exclusive of water purchased by Portsmouth for sale to the Navy on a temporary, emergency basis from September 29, 2006 through June 30, 2008.

Portsmouth seeks to intervene in this proceeding pursuant to the Rhode Island Public Utility Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Portsmouth possesses an interest that may be directly affected by the Commission's action in the proceeding and is not adequately represented by the existing parties. Portsmouth's participation in this proceeding is also clearly in the public interest.

The City of Newport has no objection to this motion to intervene.
