**Interrogatories of the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers
Set IV**

1. With reference to page 13, lines 1 through 8.
 - a. Please provide the basis for the \$50,000 annual cost for indemnity and medical payments that Mr. Edge is adding back to the annual workers' compensation claim. Include in your response all supporting documentation.
 - b. Please demonstrate how this \$50,000 amount differs from the projected annual amount of \$50,000 provided in the response to DIV 2-16.

Answer:

- a. This claim was incurred when NBC was self-insured and therefore NBC would be responsible for indemnity and medical payments on the claim. The \$50,000 is based on annual indemnity payments of \$39,520 and projected annual medical expense for treatment.
- b. The \$50,000 projected annual amount provided in the response to DIV 2-16 is for other unrelated old claims that were incurred when NBC was self-insured. The reason that the old claims amount is projected to increase by \$50,000 is because the claimant of the subject settlement has been paid through a claim incurred when the NBC was privately insured. Based upon medical information, the privately insured claim will be closed shortly and the indemnity and medical payments will then revert to the self-insured claim.

Additional activity has taken place with respect to this claimant. Should the settlement occur, NBC will provide this information to the Division.
