## NOTICE OF TECHNICAL SESSION

At this technical session National Grid will provide a description of the components of its June 1, 2009 rate application to change the Company's base distribution rates. National Grid seeks to implement new rates designed to generate additional revenues in the amount of approximately \$75.3 for a total revenue requirement of approximately \$298.5 million or 33.9 percent.
