MOTION TO INTERVENE OF BLOCK ISLAND POWER COMPANY

Now comes Block Island Power Company (BIPCo), by and through its undersigned

counsel, and pursuant to Rule 1.13 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, hereby

moves that it be allowed to intervene as a full party in this docket.

Rule 1.13(b) provides that a party may intervene when the party has an interest of such

nature that intervention is necessary or appropriate. The interest may be one in which the

proposed intervenor is directly affected by the docket, but is not adequately represented by the

existing parties, and as to which the intervenor may be bound by the Commission's action in the

proceeding. In addition, Rule 1.13 provides that intervention may be granted when the proposed

intervenor's participation is in the public interest.

This docket is a review of a filing made by National Grid pursuant to R.I.G.L. § 39-26.1-

7 regarding the statutorily designated "Town of New Shoreham project." BIPCo is the electric

utility that serves the Town of New Shoreham.

There are specific references in R.I.G.L. § 39-26.1-7 to not only BIPCo, but to the supply

of electricity to the Town of New Shoreham. These references include:

1. A requirement that the Commission find that the proposal "enhance the electric

reliability and environmental quality of the Town of New Shoreham."

2. A requirement that the Commission examine whether "there are benefits for

customers of the Block Island Power Company," and if so, the Commission "shall determine an

allocation of cost responsibility between customers of [National Grid] and customers of Block Island Power Company."

3. A requirement that "the allocation of cost shall assure that individual customers of

the Town of New Shoreham pay higher charges related to the project . . . . "

4. A requirement that "the Commission shall provide for an appropriate rate design

and billing method between [National Grid] and Block Island Power Company . . . . "

5. A requirement that if National Grid owns, operates, and maintains the cable

between the Town of New Shoreham and the mainland, the costs incurred "shall be recovered

annually through a fully reconciling rate adjustment from the customers of [National Grid]

and/or from the Block Island Power Company . . . . "

6. A statutory provision that requires that "any charges incurred by the Block Island

Power Company . . . pursuant to this section shall be recovered annually in rates . . . . "

Therefore, interests of BIPCo and the ratepayers it serves in the Town of New Shoreham

will be directly affected by the Commission's statutory review and its actions in this matter, and

the interests described above will not be adequately represented by the existing parties.

Accordingly, BIPCo respectfully moves that the Commission grant BIPCo full party

intervenor status in this docket.
