Specifically, there is a statement that appears twice in the filing letter, stating:


"In the first instance, the price that National Grid would be expected to pay for the power is far higher than all parties expected as represented to the State Legislature and is significantly above market."

The sentence should have read as stated below, but a revision was not captured correctly in the final version:

"In the first instance, the price that National Grid would be expected to pay for the power is far higher than National Grid and many parties expected when Section 39-26.1-7 was enacted."
