Whereas, Pursuant to Rule 1.28(a) of the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission through this notice of erratum corrects a "clerical mistake" contained in Commission Report and Order No. 19941, previously issued in this docket, on April 2, 2010; and

Whereas, on Page 67, footnote 334, sentence two, which reads:

“However, such consensus was not disparities of the analysis of commercially reasonable.”

is hereby corrected to read:

“However, such consensus was not dispositive of the analysis of commercially reasonable.”

Whereas, on Page 69, the fourth sentence of the first paragraph which reads:

“The Division’s calculation painted a slightly worse picture, with ratepayers potentially paying \$521 million in above market payments, while Deepwater’s estimates using a NPV analysis estimated lower values of in the range of \$98.7 million to \$152.2 million.”

is hereby corrected to read:

“The Division’s calculation painted a slightly worse picture, with ratepayers potentially paying \$400 million in above market payments, while Deepwater’s estimates using a NPV analysis estimated lower values of in the range of \$98.7 million to \$152.2 million.”

Whereas, on Page 75, the third sentence of the first paragraph which reads:

“Deepwater indisputably has a great deal at stake, and Grid stands to receive approximately \$25 million in statutorily-authorized “remuneration” payments just for signing the PPA.”

is hereby corrected to read:

“Deepwater indisputably has a great deal at stake, and Grid stands to receive approximately \$19 million in statutorily-authorized “remuneration” payments just for signing the PPA, assuming the Project produces.”¹


(19943) ORDERED:
