The evidentiary hearings will follow at 9:30 A.M., March 9, 2010 at the Commission's office.

In this docket, the Commission will examine a filing by The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid") made pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.1-7. In the filing dated December 9, 2009, National Grid seeks Commission review of a Purchase Power Agreement ("PPA") between National Grid and Deepwater Wind Block Island, LLC for the development of a renewable energy resources project of 30 megawatts or less that includes a proposal to enhance the electric reliability and environmental quality of the Town of New Shoreham ("Project") including provisions for an undersea transmission cable that would interconnect the Town of New Shoreham and the mainland of Rhode Island. The total estimated cost expected to be paid under the PPA between National Grid and Deepwater is approximately \$700 million over a twenty-year term. The PPA includes a unit price of 24.4¢ per kWh for bundled renewable energy supplies in 2013, which is the first full year of expected operation for the Project. Under the PPA, this price will escalate at a rate of 3.5% annually. If the PPA is approved, the various costs associated with the Project will be recovered from all ratepayers of National Grid and Block Island Power Company in accordance with future Commission decisions under R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.1 et seq. and R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-3-11. This docket

will not address the cost allocation between the ratepayers of National Grid and Block Island Power Company.
