**ORDER**

Whereas, on December 23, 2009, the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) denied the Narragansett Electric Company’s, d/b/a National Grid’s (“NGrid” or “Company”) proposed 2010 Demand Side Management (“DSM”) programs which are funded through a required assessment in the form of an adjustment factor.

Whereas, the Commission approved a Conservation and Load Management Adjustment and Renewable Factor of \$0.0035 per kilowatt-hour for usage on and after January 1, 2010 and ordered NGrid to apply \$0.0032 per kilowatt-hour to its electric demand side management programs and to submit an amount equal to \$0.0003 per kilowatt-hour to the State Office of Energy Resources Renewables Programs.

Whereas, the Commission ordered NGrid to file a modification of the programs originally set forth that reflected the budget approved by the Commission on February 1, 2010.

Whereas, on February 9, 2010, NGrid filed its revised Energy Efficiency Program Plan for 2010 (“Plan”) as ordered by the Commission.

Whereas, the revised Plan reduced budgets, eliminated initiatives that may be eligible for Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative funds and updated savings assumptions.

Whereas, the revised Plan represents the collaborative efforts of NGrid, the Rhode Island Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, The Energy Council of Rhode Island,

Energy Consumers Alliance of New England d/b/a People's Power & Light and Environment Northeast.

Whereas, the Commission finds that the revised Plan is just, reasonable and in the best interests of NGrid and its ratepayers.


Accordingly, it is hereby

(20005) ORDERED:

1. National Grid's Revised Energy Efficiency Program Plan and associated budget for 2010 filed on February 9, 2010 is approved.
2. NGrid shall file its proposed 2011 DSM programs and budget no later than October 15, 2010, or the parties shall file a Settlement no later than November 1, 2010 regarding proposed 2011 DSM programs and budget allocations. In the event of a direct non-settled filing by NGrid, responsive pleadings shall be made no later than November 1, 2010.
3. The Parties shall act in accordance with all other findings and instructions contained in this Report and Order.
