DEFINITION OF INDUSTRIAL USER :

ORDER

On March 29, 2010, the Narragansett Bay Commission (“NBC”) filed a tariff advice seeking to modify its definition of an Industrial customer within its tariffs. NBC noted that it has historically billed large laundries as Commercial Users as they were defined as commercial users and did not fall within the definition of Industrial Users. Recently, NBC has received inquiries regarding this classification because NBC permits large laundries to be classified as Industrial Laundries under its Pretreatment Program as defined by the Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”). The change proposed would affect less than five of its customers who would be re-categorized from commercial to industrial. NBC also noted that reclassification would result in an approximate loss of revenue of \$100,000 annually. The Division filed a memorandum indicating that it believed the tariff advice reasonable and appropriate and recommending that the Commission approve it. At an open meeting on April 27, 2010, the Commission approved NBC’s request.


Accordingly, it is hereby
