Dear Ms. Massaro:


On behalf of the Pascoag Utility District (Pascoag or the District), we herewith submit an original and nine copies of Pascoag's tariff for the sale and installation of surge suppressors.

This proposed Tariff was originally discussed and submitted on August 1, 2006 with a requested effective date of September 1, 2006.

However, PUD recently noted that this Tariff did not, in fact, have a RIPUC number. In view of the fact that several persons here at the District, as well as the Commission and Division remember this "Tariff", it apparently was an Administrative oversight in not being completed.

Therefore, as noted above, PUD hereby respectfully submits and requests approval of this Residential/Commercial/Industrial Surge Suppressors Tariff.

RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL SURGE SUPPRESSORS

Availability

Customers of the Pascoag Utility District ("Pascoag" or "the District") have the option of having Electrical Surge Suppressors installed, at no cost for such installation, on their property, by Pascoag. All customers shall be responsible for the cost of the Surge Suppressor appropriate to their service voltage.

Fees

Customers may, at their discretion, pay the cost of the Surge Suppressor in one payment prior to installation. Customers may also choose to make payments. Under this option customers will be assessed an interest free monthly fee equal to 1/12th the cost of the Surge Suppressor. Should a conflict arise between the Commission's Rules Governing the Purchase and Installation of such Surge Suppressors (the "Rules") and this provision, the Rules shall supersede.

Ownership

After the purchase of the Surge Suppressor, those customers who have either paid in one lump sum or have completed their 12 month payment plan, will own the Surge Suppressor. The Pascoag Utility District retains the right to invoice the customer for the actual cost of removal of the unit, if requested to do so by the customer. In cases where customers close their account with Pascoag before the Surge Suppressor has been completely paid for, the remaining balance will be included in their "Final Bill".

Terms and Conditions

The District's Terms and Conditions, as may be amended from time to time, and where not inconsistent with any specific provisions hereof, are a part of this provision.
