- DIV 5-1. With regard to Mr. DeCelles' Rebuttal Testimony at page 5, please state whether Mr. DeCelles or PWSB has any assurance or information that the City of Pawtucket will not pursue legislation if the increase in public fire service rates is limited to five percent. If yes, please provide complete details.
- RESPONSE: Yes. I met with Mayor James E. Doyle, and I have received a commitment that the City of Pawtucket will agree to the conditions set forth on pages 3 and 4 of Mr. Catlin's surrebuttal testimony regarding public fire protection charges. In particular, if the increase in public fire protection charges is limited to five percent (5%) (\$337.25 to \$354.11), then the City will not pursue legislation seeking an exemption from paying public fire protection charges and will agree not to take the exemption if such legislation is passed. This commitment will remain in place until the PWSB's next rate filing with the Commission.
