REQUEST COMM 1-4:

Deepwater's July 1, 2010 intervention letter states that Rhode Island has already benefited because of "interest shown by some of the world's largest manufacturing companies to locate factories in Rhode Island for wind turbine assembly, submarine cable manufacture and related business activities".

- a. Please identify the companies.
- b. Please provide copies of written commitments by these companies to locate facilities or to make investments in Rhode Island.
- c. Please quantify the value of the commitments with detailed calculations and supporting documentation.

EDC RESPONSE 1-4:

- a) Mitsubishi
XEMC New Energy Co., Ltd
- b) I believe these companies have filed their letters of interest with the Commission.
- c) These companies have not provided supporting documentation with detailed calculations at this time.

EDC SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE 1-4:
