- 1-3. If the answer to 1-2, above was in the affirmative, please provide the basis for this response. If the answer to 1-2 was in the negative, please quantify the impact of the JDA and QDA on economic development in Rhode Island.
- 1-4. Deepwater's July 1, 2010 intervention letter states that Rhode Island has already benefited because of "interest shown by some of the world's largest manufacturing companies to locate factories in Rhode Island for wind turbine assembly, submarine cable manufacture and related business activities".

 - b. Please provide copies of written commitments by these companies to locate facilities or to make investments in Rhode Island.
 - c. Please quantify the value of the commitments with detailed calculations and supporting documentation.
