- Comm. 4-2: Referencing RFC Schedule 6 Rebuttal, please provide an itemized reconciliation for each year in the "Total Offsets to Revenue Requirements", including FY 2011 Actual for Sundry, Miscellaneous and Rental Property. Please explain the year-to-year variances.
- Response: See Attached Schedule. The year to year variances can be explained as follows:

**Sundry** – The variance from the Docket 4025 amount to FY09 and FY10 is because the estimates used to prepare Docket 4025 included interest on customer accounts, which is reported separately and should not have been included in this line item. Also, actual billing was less than estimated. As for the proposed rate year, the 2012 rate year estimate was based on the actual revenue in the first six months of 2011, annualized.

**Rental of Property** - Property Rental in 2009 was low because one lease commenced in April 2009, not July 2008. Two new leases and one additional option to lease were negotiated in 2011 resulting in greater revenues in 2011.

**Miscellaneous Revenue** - Miscellaneous revenue in 2009 was higher than the Docket 4025 amount because it included \$22,429 of 2008 insurance refunds. Miscellaneous revenue in 2010 was higher than the Docket 4025 amount because it included \$31,872 of 2008 property tax rebates from the Town of Portsmouth.
