ORDER ON MOTION TO AMEND ORDER

WHEREAS, On June 30, 2011, the Commission issued Order No. 20395, granting Cox Rhode Island Telcom, L.L.C's waiver request for the release of a contiguous block of 100 numbers within a 1000 block that had been denied by the North American Numbering Association based on Cox's months to exhaust projection; and

WHEREAS, In its Order, the Commission required Cox to return the 900 unused numbers and stated that "Cox shall file with the Commission a copy of the Part 4 (certifying numbers in service) and a copy of the Block Donation Form (certifying return of a block) that it needed to file with NANPA. Return of the block is to be made within 30 days of putting the numbers into service."; and

WHEREAS, On July 8, 2011, Cox filed a letter stating that since the issuance of the Commission's Order No. 20395, Cox had identified four customers requiring 800 additional numbers which could be provided using the numbers Cox received from NANPA; and

WHEREAS, Cox requested the Commission amend its Order No. 20395 to allow Cox to retain all 1000 numbers in the NPA-NXX 401-680-4 to serve those customers; and

WHEREAS, At an Open Meeting on July 26, 2011, the Commission approved Cox's request.


Accordingly, it is

(20436) ORDERED:

1. That Ordering paragraph 3 of Commission Order No. 20395 is hereby amended such that Cox Rhode Island Telcom, L.L.C. may retain the numbers in NPA-NXX 401-680-4.
