Request:

Please reconcile the ARP Actual Program Spend for the 12 months ended June 30, 2011 to the total capital spending for the 12 months ended June 30, 2011. The response should explain how the ARP capital spending was identified from the total capital spending.

Response:

National Grid's capital spend is classified into four primary categories; Growth, Mandated, Reliability, and Discretionary. Within the Mandated Program category, the ARP spending is recorded and tracked in two separate sub-categories as shown below on Line 3 (Proactive Main Replacements - Leak Prone Pipe) and Line 4 (Proactive Service Replacements BS HP - Leak Prone Services). The spending is provided for the 12 months ending March 31, 2011. The ARP sunset and was incorporated April 1, 2011 into the Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability program in Docket No. 4219.
