
Dear Ms. Massaro:

This letter is submitted to advise the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission of the ongoing meetings and discussions between National Grid¹ and the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (“Division”) relative to the Company’s proposed amendments to the gas marketer tariffs, including the capacity release provisions, that were the subject of the above-referenced proceeding.

In its order in this docket, the Commission directed the Company and the Division to meet and work to attempt to resolve various outstanding issues relative to the Company’s proposed modifications. To date the Division and the Company have met on a number of occasions, among themselves as well as in larger groups attended by the Rhode Island gas marketers. These discussions are continuing, and the Company and the Division request additional time, until July 1, to complete their work and report back to the Commission.


