ORDER

WHEREAS, On August 31, 2011, Telrite Corporation d/b/a Lifeline Wireless (“Telrite” or “Company”) filed with the Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) a Petition for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) throughout its service area in the State of Rhode Island pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 214(e)¹ in order to provide discounted service to low income customers and receive certain subsidies from the Federal Universal Service Fund (“Petition”); and

WHEREAS, Under this pre-paid wireless telecommunications service, Telrite will provide handsets to lifeline participants free of charge (only one participant per household) and will offer four plans including one with sixty-eight (68) minutes free of charge after the application of the Lifeline discount; and

WHEREAS, Because it is a pre-paid service, there is no concern that customers be protected from long-distance charges as there is with landline ETC service; and

WHEREAS, Telrite has indicated that it will discount its customary \$60 activation fee by \$30 and customers may either pay the \$30 up front or over a twelve-month period with no interest; and

WHEREAS, Telrite has been allowed ETC status in seven other states; and

¹ 47 U.S.C. 214(e) imposed statutory responsibility upon the Commission to certify telecommunications service providers as “eligible” to receive funds from the Federal Universal Service Fund.

WHEREAS, Telrite responded to data requests issued by the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (“Division”); and

WHEREAS, On November 14, 2011, the Commission issued a Public Notice to Solicit Comments regarding the Petition. No comments were received; and

WHEREAS, On November 25, 2011, the Division filed a Letter with the Commission recommending approval of Telrite’s Petition on the basis that the Company had adequately met all of the Commission’s requirements in the ETC Rules; and

WHEREAS, The Commission is of the opinion that Telrite’s petition for ETC designation is proper, complies with the federal and state requirements, and is in the best interest of ratepayers; and


Accordingly, it is hereby

- 1) Telrite Corporation d/b/a Lifeline Wireless is hereby designated as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier throughout its service area for receiving universal service support.



NOTICE OF RIGHT OF APPEAL PURSUANT TO R.I.G.L.
