ORDER

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2011, Pascoag Utility District (“Pascoag” or “PUD”) filed its proposed Demand Side Management (“DSM”) plan and budget for 2012 with the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”); and

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2011, the Commission approved Pascoag’s proposed plan and associated budget which included a \$28,659 carry-over from Pascoag’s 2011 DSM plan; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2012, Pascoag requested approval to reallocate \$21,190 of its \$146,893 budget to certain of its more active programs; and

WHEREAS, Pascoag specifically proposed reallocating \$5,027 in the Committed for 2011 Program, \$4,975 in the Country Farms Project, \$1,305 from the Burrillville High School Project and \$7,688 from the Funds for Follow-up to Successful Programs for a total of \$18,995 being reallocated to the Brothers of Sacred Heart Lighting Project; and \$1,110 and \$1,085 from the Burrillville High School Project to the Outreach Education Program and the PUD 6th Annual Green Festival respectively; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2012, the Division recommended that the Commission approve Pascoag’s proposed reallocation of \$21,190; and


WHEREAS, at an open meeting on June 12, 2012, the Commission considered and approved Pascoag’s request.

Accordingly, it is hereby


(20777) ORDERED:

1. Pascoag Utility District's request to reallocate \$21,190 in its 2012 Demand Side Management Programs budget is approved.


