Motion of George Wiley Center to Intervene as a Full Party


George Wiley Center, by its attorney, moves under Rule 1.13 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) to intervene as a full party in this action of the following grounds:

1. George Wiley Center's mission is to conduct community organizing and advocacy on behalf of all low-income Rhode Islanders.
2. George Wiley Center has a long history of advocacy on behalf of low-income Rhode Islanders before the PUC.
3. Intervention is necessary and appropriate under Rule 1.13(b). The Center's low-income constituents will be directly and uniquely affected by the rates and charges under review in Docket No. 4323.
4. George Wiley Center asks that low-income customers receiving service under the A-60 rate be held harmless from any increase in electric or natural gas distribution rates, and that the number of customers receiving service under low income rates be expanded to be consistent with the actual number of residential customers that are income-eligible to receive such rate.

WHEREFORE, George Wiley Center asks that its motion be granted.
