

As directed during the conference call in this matter on September 5, Verizon New England Inc., d/b/a Verizon Rhode Island ("Verizon RI"), hereby responds to the tariff revisions filed by YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax") dated August 27, 2012, which YMax states is intended to reverse the objectionable tariff changes that YMax had filed on June 1, 2012.
