At this hearing, the Commission will review the propriety of a need and cost analysis recommendation to be submitted by the Rhode Island Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Energy Resources and Statewide Planning Program to the Commission, prior to the issuance of an advisory opinion to the RI Energy Facility Siting Board ("Siting Board"), regarding the need and cost-justification of National Grid's proposal to construct and alter transmission lines and facilities in the Towns of Burrillville and North Smithfield (as part of the Interstate Reliability Project) which application is pending before the Siting Board. Due to specific Commission mandate under the Energy Facility Siting Act, speakers will be limited to their comments, to the Commission, to a discussion "as to the need to relocate the transmission lines."
