- Q. Please identify any steps NBC is currently taking to sell REC's in connection with the Wind Turbine project.
- A. The NBC has contracted with La Capra Associates to assist with the selling of the RECs. NBC's Wind Turbine Project has qualified as a Class 1 resource Renewable Energy Generation Unit with both the State of Rhode Island and the State of Massachusetts. The NBC must now decide between forward sales and post generation sales. If the forward sale option is selected, NBC must also decide between firm sales, unit contingent sales or a blend of firm and unit contingent. NBC must also consider if the sale should be constructed as a multi-year contract to a single party or sale to multiple parties with additional consideration to competitive solicitation. These decisions are anticipated to occur over in the near future, in consultation with La Capra Associates, as the NBC seeks to maximize the revenues from the RECs while minimizing the risk.
