<u>ORDER</u>

On October 17, 2013, Pascoag Utility District (hereinafter Pascoag) submitted a Request for an LED Street Light Incentive to be funded with existing Demand Side Management funds. Included with the Request was a report detailing the specifics and the success of its LED Streetlight Pilot Program for which it was able to secure a total of fifty-six fixtures for \$13,311.84. In the Request for an LED Street Light Incentive, Pascoag proposed using \$5,000, which it allocated to a line item called LED Street Light Incentives in its 2013 DSM filing previously approved by the Public Utilities Commission (hereinafter PUC) and \$8,732.60 of Demand Side Management payments made by Danielle Prosciutto, Inc., a large commercial customer, to purchase an additional seventy LED street lights. Pascoag noted that, if approved, the total incentive of \$13,732.60 would cover fifty percent of the total cost of the project.


On October 25, 2013, the PUC at an open meeting unanimously approved Pascoag's Request. In light of the success of Pascoag's Pilot Program, the PUC agrees that by continuing the program, Pascoag will save additional energy while also providing improved lighting quality, all of which will be beneficial to its ratepayers.
