**LED STREET LIGHT TARIFF ADVICE** : **DOCKET NO. 4392**

**ORDER**

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2013, Pascoag Utility District (“Pascoag”) filed a Tariff Advice to revise its existing RIPUC No. 605 Public and Private Lighting Rates; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for public street lighting, in service in Pascoag’s service territory within the Village of Harrisville is assessed to the Harrisville Fire District; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for public street lighting in service in Pascoag’s service territory in the Village of Pascoag is assessed to all classes of electric customers, within the Village of Pascoag, equally; and

WHEREAS, the Tariff Advice proposed changes to the existing street light tariff allowing for the addition of energy efficient LED street lights and the inclusion of Rhode Island sales tax to be charged where applicable; and

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2013, the Division suggested a modification to the original filing to clarify that Rhode Island sales tax would be charged to customers of the Village of Pascoag where applicable; and

WHEREAS, Pascoag represented that placing the LED street lights in service would result in a monthly decrease to customers in the Village of Pascoag of \$0.03 per

customer per class and an annual decrease to the Harrisville Fire District of \$720.12 per year; and


WHEREAS, the Division recommended approval of the modification that included its proposed modification as set forth above.

Accordingly, it is

(20996) ORDERED:

1. The tariff advice filed by Pascoag incorporating the modification recommended by the Division is approved.
