Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws 39-1-1 et seq, as amended, and 47 U.S.C. §§151–760, the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") will accept written public comments regarding the Application for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") in the State of Rhode Island for the limited purpose of offering Lifeline Services to qualified households filed by 1) Global Connection, Inc. of America d/b/a STAND UP WIRELESS on September 30, 2013, and 2) Q LINK WIRELESS, LLC on October 17, 2103 (collectively, "Companies"). Both Companies seek ETC designation in order to receive funding from the federal Universal Service Fund to offer subsidized wireless service to eligible low-income consumers in the state of Rhode Island.

In these dockets, the PUC will examine the propriety of the Companies' respective application to make a determination that the Companies have met the statutory and regulatory requirements to be designated as an ETC to receive funding from the available federal universal support mechanism and has complied with the PUC's Rules and Regulations Governing the Certification and Verification Procedures for Telecommunications Carriers Eligible to Receive Payments From the Federal Universal Service Fund.
