ORDER

WHEREAS, On November 26, 2013, Coxcom, LLC (Company) filed with the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (PUC) an application seeking certification for its CCI New England 181 kW (DC) Solar PV Generation Unit, a 0.181 MW solar energy generation unit located in West Warwick, Rhode Island, as an eligible New Renewable Energy Resource in accordance with the PUC's Rules and Regulations Governing the Implementation of a Renewable Energy Standard (RES Rules) and R.I. Gen Laws § 39-26-1<sup>1</sup>; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 6.0 and other relevant sections of the RES Rules, a thirty day period for public comment was provided during which time no such comment was received; and

WHEREAS, On February 4, 2014, February 20, 2014, and February 21, 2014 supplemental and clarifying information was provided to PUC Staff and their application review consultant in response to the application review consultant's January 15, 2014 and February 21, 2014 requests for said information; and

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

All RECs associated with the production of eligible energy that are minted on or after the effective date are eligible for the RES.


5) That, although the PUC will rely upon the NEPOOL GIS for verification of production of energy from the Company's Generation Unit certified as eligible in this Order, the Company will provide information and access as necessary to the PUC, or persons acting at its behest, to conduct audits or site visits to assist in verification of continued eligibility for and compliance with RI RES Certification at any time at the PUC's discretion.

6) That the Company shall notify the PUC in the event of a change in the facility's eligibility status.


