## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Law § 39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a hearing on Monday, October 26, 2014 @ 9:30 A.M. in Hearing Room A of the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The purpose of this hearing is to examine the propriety of two filings by The Narragansett Electric d/b/a National Grid seeking approval of implement revised Electric Infrastructure, System and Reliability (ISR) factors in Docket No. 4473 and revised Gas ISR factors in Docket No. 4474.

In Docket No. 4373, National Grid requests to recover a one-time adjustment of \$1,410,826 for Net Operating Losses (NOL) understated in the Company's prior electric ISR revenue requirement for fiscal years 2012, 2013 and 2014. The Company also seeks to include a cumulative revenue requirement of \$760,233 for assets placed in service during years 2012, 2013 and 2014. The impact on a typical residential customer receiving Standard Offer Service and using 500 kWh per month will result in a monthly bill increase of \$0.54 from \$99.02 to \$99.56.

In Docket No. 4474, National Grid requests to recover a one-time adjustment of \$3,537,706 for Net Operating Losses understated in the Company's prior gas ISR revenue requirement for fiscal years 2012, 2013 and 2014. The Company also seeks to include a cumulative revenue requirement of \$13,136,888 for fiscal years 2012, 2013 and 2014. The impact on a typical residential heating customer using 846 therms annually will result in an annual bill increase of \$22.59 from \$1,250.19 to \$1,272.78. The PUC may approve different rates that may be higher or lower than those proposed by National Grid. The PUC may rule immediately at the conclusion of the hearing.

The filings may be examined at the PUC's office. The filings can also be accessed under the PUC's Docket Menu at <a href="www.ripuc.org">www.ripuc.org</a>, Docket Nos. 4473 and 4474. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the Rhode Island General Laws.

The PUC is accessible to the handicapped. Individuals requesting interpreter services for the hearing impaired must notify the Commission Clerk's office at 780-2107, seventy-two hours in advance of hearing date.
